

# Inverell Bushwalking Club Inc

## An Introduction to the Club

To join the club it is first necessary to become a Prospective Member by filling out an **Application for Membership** form (available from the Downloads page of our website) and returning it with the fee to the address below. Prospective membership is valid for three months and enables you to see if you like the club and its activities before becoming a full member.

### **IMPORTANT**

**Our Public Liability and Personal Accident insurance does not cover non-members. Visitors, therefore, are not permitted to attend club activities unless they first become a Prospective Member.**

Prospective membership of the club costs **\$5** (this is for one person or for a family of two adults and any children who are full time students living at home) and is valid for **three months**. Towards the end of this period we will send you a form inviting you to apply for full membership.

Full single membership is currently **\$20** a year, and family membership (which includes parents and children as per above) is **\$35** a year to the end of the current financial year. Children over 18 years who are not full time students and not living at home will need to apply for separate membership. Please note that if you are including dependent children under 18 years you will also need to provide the club with a Risk Waiver for a Child form before that child attends its first club activity. If you do not have this form please contact the secretary.

Club meetings are held at 7.30 pm on the second Wednesday of every second month, that is, in March, May, July, September, and November. The meetings are in the Common Room at Inverell High School. Come in the main Brae Street entrance and turn right. These are fairly informal affairs and provide members and visitors a chance to discuss future walks and reminisce on past ones. Visitors are always welcome.

The interests of club members cover a wide range of activities such as bushwalking, canoeing, local history, family camping, nature photography, conservation, bird watching and botany. A small but informative newsletter is mailed to members five times a year.

**If there is a walk that you would like to go on it is essential that you contact the leader at least a few days prior to the programmed date.**
